MEETING PROGRAMME

The topic for the period before the mobility is AIR so every school will focus on that. Students will work with their teachers of biology or chemistry and discuss the issue of clean atmosphere, air pollution, impact of traffic and local heating systems, ways to prevent the air pollution. The results of their findings at each school will be shared on Twinspace and the data will be used for the presentation during the mobility in Czechia. The expected tools to work is data analysis, research on internet and/or in libraries, school lessons focused on air pollution, discussions, field trips to local power plants or ecology organisations. Everybody will brainstorm three main points:

- 1) what is the biggest problem about air pollution in your area
- 2) what is being done to improve the situation
- 3) what are the future steps of your local government.

Results will be also shared on Twinspace and then presented at the mobility. Those who will participate in the short-term student exchange will present the results personally. Those who will stay in their schools will have a chance to follow their classmates online because photos, videos, chats and other materials will be uploaded on eTwinning platform regularly so that everybody can see the daily programme of the project meeting abroad. At the end of the mobility on Friday all participants will be asked to work on Newsletter (as they do after each mobility) with their photos, experiences, impressions, ideas. The newsletter will be a shared document on Google docs where all participants can contribute with their ideas. It will be available to the public on internet. They will also fill in the questionnaire where they will evaluate the meeting and give feedback to the organizing school, what to make better, what to change in the future.

Arrival and accommodation in hotel Boršičanka.

Monday 30th August 2021

8:00 departure by bus in front of the hotel in direction [Dlouhé Stráně](#) where we will have a guided tour of a unique power plant in the mountains. Lunch provided after the tour (14:00). On the way back a short stop in [Karlova Studánka](#) where you can breathe the cleanest air in Central Europe.

Tuesday 31st August 2021

8:00 departure on a trip to [Štramberk castle](#), [Zdeněk Burian](#) museum, [Šipka](#) cave, [Botanical garden](#) and [watch tower](#). On the way back (if we have time) visit to the [leaning church](#) in Karviná (Czech Pisa). Dinner provided at the hotel.

Wednesday 1st September 2021

8:00 departure and visit to Industrial museum in Ostrava with a workshop on ecology and a film show. Lunch provided at school. Afternoon activities depending on the weather.

Thursday 2nd September 2021

8:30 Tour of the town, meanders of the Lučina river, lunch at school and afternoon outdoor activities prepared by CZ students

Friday 3rd September 2021

8:30 School tour, if possible participation in lessons, newsletter and questionnaire.

Lunch at school and free time in the afternoon.

Saturday 5th June 2021

Departure of all participants
